National Provider Identifiers Registry

The Administrative Simplification provisions of the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 (HIPAA) mandated the adoption of standard unique identifiers for health care providers and health plans. The purpose of these provisions is to improve the efficiency and effectiveness of the electronic transmission of health information. The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) has developed the National Plan and Provider Enumeration System (NPPES) to assign these unique identifiers.

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<i>NPI</i>	1831969179	10-position all-numeric identification number assigned by the NPS to uniquely identify a health care provider.
<i>Entity Type</i>	Individual	Code describing the type of health care provider that is being assigned an NPI. Codes are:

<i>Provider Credential Text</i>	LMSW	The abbreviations for professional degrees or credentials used or held by the provider, if the provider is an individual. Examples are MD, DDS, CSW, CNA, AA, NP, RNA, or PSY. These credential designations will not be verified by NPS.
<i>Provider First Line Business Mailing Address</i>	800 IRVING AVE RM C104	The first line mailing address of the provider being identified. This data element may

<i>Provider Enumeration Date</i>	01/08/2024	The date the provider was assigned a unique identifier (assigned an NPI).
<i>Last Update Date</i>	01/08/2024	The date that a record was last updated or changed.
<i>Provider Gender Code</i>	F	The code designating the provider's gender if the provider is a person.
