National Provider Identifiers Registry

The Administrative Simplification provisions of the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 (HIPAA) mandated the adoption of standard unique identifiers for health care providers and health plans. The purpose of these provisions is to improve the efficiency and effectiveness of the electronic transmission of health information. The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) has developed the National Plan and Provider Enumeration System (NPPES) to assign these unique identifiers.

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<i>Provider Middle Name</i>	A.	The middle name of the provider, if the provider is an individual.
<i>Provider Name Prefix Text</i>	DR.	The name prefix or salutation of the provider if the provider is an individual; for example, Mr

<i>Provider Business Practice Location Address City Name</i>	GREENVILLE	The city name in the location address of the provider being identified.
<i>Provider Business Practice Location Address State Name</i>	SC	The State or Province name in the location address
